1. NGS updates

a. National Society of Professional Surveyors or NSPS (Howe) – NSPS has inquired if NGS and other organizations would like to participate in a national meeting next spring in Washington D.C. It is envisioned to be a "conference of conferences" from various organizations. NSPS would like input from potential participants, exhibitors, and presenters by April 1.

Q (Beaverson): Would the National Height Mod partner meeting be held at that time.

A (Gallagher): It is being discussed, but we're cognizant the 2013 and 2014 meetings have both been relatively far east, and that the Great Lakes has expressed interest in hosting in 2014.

2. State Updates


- a. **Illinois** (**Holden**) IL Height Mod will be going to the ESRI User conference this year and is planning a 2 panel poster session on Height Modernization programs. They are requesting other state and federal agencies to send Height Mod project posters to include in the Height Mod display. There will be 16 slots for posters, and the session will be Monday July 14th, 2014. Point of contact: Janet Holden, Illinois State Geological Survey (jthornhi@illinois.edu)
- b. Western Region (Martin/Schulz) A group has formed across the western states, and we held our first meeting on March 10 with eighteen individuals calling in. Our first meeting was still focused on introductions / sharing of experience, as there is diversity in the group. Some states have extensive experience with Height Mod projects, while other may be interested in help from the basics. There is interest across the group in participating in GPS on Benchmarks campaign, specifically CO DOT, WA, Southern California (Los Angeles and Ventura County). There is also strong interest across the group in receiving OPUS-Projects training and staying aware of developments with the overhaul of NGS 58-59. Next, the group plans to reach out to Height Mod partners in the Great Lakes to learn from their experience in collaborating as a region.
- **c. Alaska** (**Kalen**) The Alaska Surveying and Mapping Conference will begin week of March 24. It's a large conference that brings together both the surveying/remote sensing and GIS communities of practice. It will include multiple NGS presentations and an OPUS Projects training.
- **d. Ohio** (Conner) Will be hosting a workshop with OPUS projects, blue booking, and ADJUST on April 22-25.
