NOAA's National Geodetic Survey (NGS) is announcing upcoming changes to the National Spatial Reference System (NSRS).

These changes are detailed in a Federal Register Notice, [Upcoming Changes to the National Spatial Reference System \(NSRS\)](#), published on Friday, July 24.

NGS is Considering Observation Age Limits

NGS also published a Federal Register Notice on Friday, July 24, [Consideration of Potential Age-Limiting Observations To Be Used To Compute 2020.00 Reference Epoch Coordinates in the National Spatial Reference System](#).

This announcement provides users of the NSRS with advance notice that geodetic control points of interest to them should be re-surveyed for the most accurate representation of geodetic coordinates, including heights.
